One Canoe, One Family. This signifies an important milestone in our school's history as we move forward, fully committed to a bilingual delivery of learning.



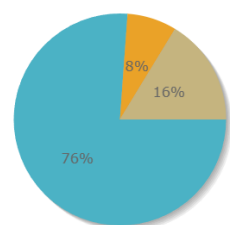

Thank you FBS whānau for always being in our corner, it means so much and makes all the things that we want to do possible.

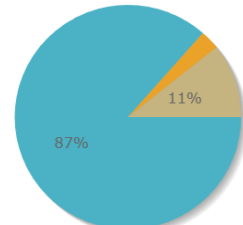

Attendance by team for Week 3

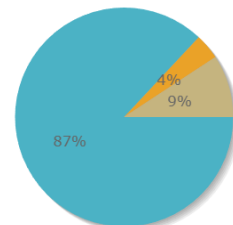
