Room 7 - Creating with Shapes

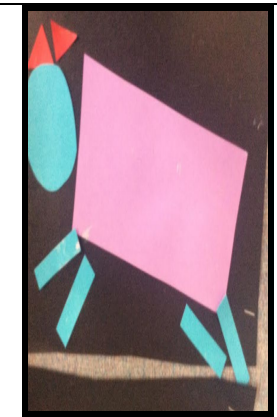

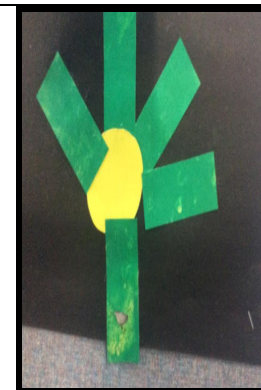
